

DIA DE CIENCIAS

The Dia De Ciencias event is designed to expose pre-college students and families to the profound possibilities of pursuing a career in STEM. NJIT Student-led organizations come together with NJIT SHPE to host workshops ranging from Bread Boards, Bridge Integrity Competitions and more. Parents also receive workshop training on supporting their children mentally, the financial aid application and more.



LATIN NIGHT & 12 CORAZONES

As the leading Hispanics in STEM, we value the diversity of our culture and believe that social events strongly unite our community/familia. Latin Night and 12 Corazones are two popular events filled with latin music, food and fun that secure more than 200 students in attendance annually.

HOW TO SUPPORT US

OVERVIEW

The SHPE National Convention is the largest annual gathering of Hispanics in STEM, expecting 22,000+ attendees this year. The event features educational workshops, award ceremonies, networking events, a graduate school expo, and a career fair.

This year, NJIT SHPE is aiming to sponsor 50 undergraduate students to attend the SHPE National Convention that will take place in Philadelphia, PA, from October 29th to November 1st.



COST BREAKDOWN

\$700 / STUDENT

SHPE Bulk Registration	Value
Hotel Costs: 4 days, 3 nights, 3-4 students per room	\$345 x 50 students = \$17,250
Transportion: 50 students	\$60 x 50 students = \$3,000
Lodging/Hotel: 1 sponsored food	\$245 x 50 students = \$12,250
Miscellaneous Costs: Meals and fees	\$50 x 50 students = \$2,500
TOTAL	\$35,000



HOW TO SUPPORT US

HOW YOU CAN HELP US: SPONSORSHPE

There are two types of sponsorships:

GENERAL SPONSORSHIPS

- Bronze = \$3,000
- Silver = \$5,500
- Gold = \$8,000







NATIONAL CONFERENCE SPONSORSHIP (SPONSORING STUDENTS)

Out of 50 students, we can offer: 8 Computer Science, 8 Mechanical Engineering, 8 Electrical & Computer Engineering, 8 Biomedical Engineering, 8 Computer Engineering, 5 Chemical Engineering, and 5 other (Finance, Data Analytics, IT).

There are two parameters. Companies may select students based on: (1) Major (2) Year. It is up to the company how many students they want to sponsor.

Example:

Cost of 10 students (of their choice of major and year): \$550 x 10 tickets = \$5,500 total

- \$345 Registration
- \$245 Hotel
- \$60 Transportation
- \$50 Miscellaneous
